Post-doctoral research fellow position at McGill University Pulmonary and HIV immunity

A post-doc research position is available at the department of Medicine, McGill University to work on a collaborative research project on pulmonary immunity during HIV infection. The CIHR-funded project is part of the Canadian HIV Cure Enterprise (CanCURE) and aims to assess the immunological mechanisms involved in HIV persistence within the lungs of HIV-infected individuals. The candidate will be cosupervised by Dr Cecilia Costiniuk, Assistant Professor in Infectious Diseases at McGill (principal supervisor) and Dr Mohammad-Ali Jenabian Assistant Professor in Immunology and holder of a Canada research chair at UQAM (co-supervisor).
